VEGETABLES:

Class 1. Potatoes: - three tubers, washing permitted

Class 2. Tomatoes: - three specimens in each class 2a) Slicing tomatoes 2b) Cherry Tomatoes 2c) Other varieties

Class 3. Squash: 3a) Summer varieties, including zucchini - two specimens 3b) Winter varieties - one specimen

Class 4. Onions: three specimens, any variety, trimmed but NOT peeled

Class 5. Carrots, five specimen

Class 6. Beets: five specimens

Class 7. Cucumbers: two specimens, slicing varieties

Class 8. A Basket of mixed vegetables - at least three kinds. Presentation counts.

FLOWERS:

Class 9. Chrysanthemums: one spray

Class 10 Marigolds: 10a) three dwarf stems under 3" 10b) three tall stems over 3"

Class 11. Calendulas: three stems

Class 12. Roses: 12a) one bloom, any variety. 12b) one spray, any variety

Class 13. Miniature Roses: 12a) One bloom, any variety 13b) one spray, any variety

Class 14. Gladiolus: one stalk

Class 15. Aster: one stem

Class 16. Dahilia: one bloom – 16a) one bloom under 4" 16b) one bloom over 4"

Class 17. Zinnia: one stem

Class 18. Cosmos: three blooms

Class 19. Rudbeckia: one stem

Class 20. Sunflower: miniature, one stalk

Class 21. Sedum: three stems

Class 22. Any annual or perennial bloom not listed above.

DESIGN CLASS:

Class 23. "September Sunset" a horizontal design

PRIZES:
