VEGETABLES:

Class 1. **Potatoes:** - three tubers, washing permitted

Class 2. **Tomatoes:** - three specimens in each class

2a) Slicing tomatoes

2b) Cherry Tomatoes

2c) Other varieties

Class 3. **Squash:**

3a) Summer varieties, including zucchini - two specimens

3b) Winter varieties - one specimen

Class 4. **Onions:** three specimens, any variety, trimmed but NOT peeled

Class 5. **Carrots:** five specimen

Class 6. **Beets:** five specimens

Class 7. **Cucumbers:** two specimens, slicing varieties

Class 8. A **Basket of mixed vegetables** - at least three kinds. Presentation counts.

FLOWERS:

Class 9. **Chrysanthemums:** one spray

Class 10 **Marigolds:**

10a) three dwarf stems under 3"

10b) three tall stems over 3"

Class 11. **Calendulas:** three stems

Class 12. **Roses:**

12a) one bloom, any variety.

12b) one spray, any variety

Class 13. **Miniature Roses:**

13a) One bloom, any variety

13b) one spray, any variety

Class 14. **Gladiolus:** one stalk

Class 15. **Aster:** one stem

Class 16. **Dahlia:** one bloom –

16a) one bloom under 4"

16b) one bloom over 4"

Class 17. **Zinnia:** one stem

Class 18. **Cosmos:** three blooms

Class 19. **Rudbeckia:** one stem

Class 20. **Sunflower:** miniature, one stalk

Class 21. **Sedum:** three stems

Class 22. Any annual or perennial bloom not listed above.

DESIGN CLASS:

Class 23. "Summer Twilight" a Modern Mass Design.
